The District entered into an agreement with Raftelis Financial Consultants, an independent consulting firm in August of 2023 to evaluate the Districts rate and fee structure. The results of this study were presented to the Board of Directors over the course of the study

and recommendations were adopted during the regular Board meeting on January 10th, 2024. The study was performed on a cost of service approach ensuring the quality collection, treatment and reclamation of sanitary sewer

flows within the District. As such the following rate plan was adopted and the District

Rules and Regulations were updated to accurately reflect the proposed changes starting with rate increases in April of 2024.

EPA Approved Pretreatment Program

The St Vrain Sanitation District is required by EPA to have an Approved Industrial Pretreatment Program because of certain growth milestones within our service area. This program is to ensure water quality standards are met, and our treatment facilities and the local environment is protected. While the District

has always been operating under this program guidance, and now EPA has formally asked us to form and submit this program for approval.

Within the program submittal and approval process, the District had to create and/or submit the following documents or policies:

- Rules and Regulations Legal Authority for implementing 40 CFR 403 regulations.
 - Local Limits Local discharge limitations for all District Users
- Permit Template Legally binding agreement between the District and the Industrial User on discharge, reporting, and compliance requirements.
- Enforcement Response Plan Guidance document outlining and defining response actions for District staff managing violations.
- Staffing Plan Budget and allocation of resources within the District for the program
- Industrial User Inventory List of all non-residential users.

This program approval will allow the District to adhere to our mission statement to better protect the local environment and the community. The District is adhering to all Federal requirements for Public Participation. Should I use Root X?

If you live in the older areas of Frederick, Firestone, or Dacono, your sewer service line probably looks like the pictures shown below. This is especially true in sewer lines constructed with clay tile pipe. The sewer line from the house to the main line is the <u>responsibility of the property owner</u>.



Over time, roots may plug the line and if left untreated it may cause the line to break. It can take less than a year for enough tree roots to grow inside your sewer pipe to create a blockage big enough to prevent your wastewater from flowing past it. This can create a sewer backup in your basement or bathroom and can eventually break the pipe

causing raw sewage to seep into your yard. St. Vrain Sanitation District recommends using a product called Root-X. This product is designed to remove the roots from your sewer service line for up to 12 months without harming the trees or shrubs. It won't fix your service line but may prolong its life and prevent costly line backups and line cleaning bills
